Artificial Feeding & Hydration

- IV & Subcutaneous Hydration
- TPN (short-term)
- Tube feeds (NG, G-tube)

Ascites Management

- Paracentesis/Thoracentesis (outpatient)
- PleurX Catheter

Iv Therapies

- Antibiotics (short-term)
- Inotropes & Vasopressors (in transit, DC'd upon arrival home)
- PCA/CADD pump
- Port-a-cath, PIV, PICC

Respiratory Support & Airway Management

- BiPAP & CPAP
- High Flow Oxygen (up to 60L with FiO2 limitations)
- Home Extubation
- Trach w/Collar (without Mechanical Ventilator)
- Trilogy (Non-invasive Ventilation)

- Intermittent GOMCO Suction
- Nephrostomy Tubes
