How soon will care begin?	Initial Visit within 7-10 days	Same day
Frequency of Visits	At least once a month	Several times a week or more

Nursing Home Visits	Yes, for contracted health plans/groups	Yes
Approach to Symptom Management & Medications	Consulting Provider: Prescriptions provided, adjustments made to existing interventions and nurses available for after hours crisis visits	Primary Provider: Frequent evaluation and management of patient's comfort by a specialist team & Attending Physician. Medications ordered & delivered
Supplies Provided?	No	Yes (medical and personal care supplies)
Medical Equipment Provided?	No	Yes

Additional Services?	Advanced care planning, assistance navigating treatment options and resources. Home Health, Infusion Pharmacy, Outpatient Physicians to remain involved for primary care management	Support & training for family and caregivers. Continuous Care & General Inpatient Care to manage out of control symptoms, Respite Care at a nursing home for caregiver relief
How long can a patient receive care?	Depends on care needs and coverage provider. Care may increase with disease progression	Unlimited while patient remains hospice appropriate
Who pays for our care?	Contracted Health Plans and Groups below	Medicare, Medi-Cal and private insurance
Can a patient also receive curative treatments?	Yes	Not for the primary hospice diagnosis
